Indications  
ACIDONIQ® Dry is indicated for:

- Prevention of bacterial and fungal digestive disorders caused by contaminated raw materials and feed
- Improvement of protein digestion and mineral absorption through enzyme activation in the gastrointestinal system
- Reduction of pathogenic bacterial populations by lowering gastrointestinal pH
- Broad-spectrum activity against gastrointestinal pathogens
- Reduction of gastrointestinal disorders such as diarrhea
- Positive effects on gastrointestinal epithelial cells and enhancement of intestinal villi growth
- Protection of feed against spoilage and bacterial/fungal contamination
- Improvement of feed conversion rate (FCR) and enhancement of flock growth and production performance
- Reduction of ammonia production and other growth-depressing metabolites

Dosage and Administration

- Broilers:  
0.5 – 2 kg ACIDONIQ® Dry per ton of feed
- Breeders and Layers:  
1 – 2 kg ACIDONIQ® Dry per ton of feed

Dosage and duration should be prescribed by a veterinarian.

Contraindications

Withdrawal Period

Drug Interactions

Storage Conditions

- Store at room temperature
- Protect from humidity and direct sunlight
- Keep the bags tightly closed

Precautions

- Use under the supervision of a veterinarian
- Keep out of reach of children
- Protect skin and eyes using suitable protective equipment (gloves, mask, and goggles) during handling
